Characteristics and typical applications **CARBO CuNi 30 Fe** is a copper-nickel electrode with a basic coating for joining and surfacing alloys of similar composition with up to 30% nickel as well as non-ferrous alloys and dissimilar steel grades. The deposit weld metal is highly resistant to seawater, typical applications include usage in shipbuilding, oil refineries, food processing industry, the engineering of general corrosion proof vessels and equipment.
